Box Project for Foodshelves



Create a celebration in a box—All ages.

Encourage a classroom or local community to bring a sealed cake mix, icing, and candle package for a foodshelf celebration box. Read *A Birthday Cake Is No Ordinary Cake* while decorating birthday boxes – You provide the boxes, decorating tools, and food shelf delivery.

Supplies needed:

Cake boxes or other small boxes to decorate (White cake boxes fold flat and are easy to color but any boxes will do.) Provide an array of the following: Markers, stickers, crayons, tape, ribbon, scissors, glue, magazines for collage cutouts, crayons, ribbon, glitter pens or inks – whatever is on hand. Optional additions: aluminum baking pans, napkins, cake plates, small books or toys

Photograph the boxes. Add to your website. Pass the idea to classroom, churches, or scout troops.
